



SEASON 2021 APPEAL PROCESS

1. Please be aware the grounds of appeal are for the following only:
 - Another player was given an advantage over another player
 - One player was disadvantaged
 - Appeals cannot simply be because you are of the belief that you/and or your child are a better player than someone else. You need to be aware that the graders have many reasons for grading a certain way,

2. Once your appeal is submitted you will be advised what time your appeal will be held.
You are able to attend however it is not compulsory

3. The appeals committee will hear your appeal. They will only decide whether the appeal is to be upheld or dismissed. They are not there to make regrading decisions, only simply to ensure that each player was given the same opportunity as each other.

4. If your appeal is dismissed, you may appeal to Gosford Netball Association.

5. If your appeal is upheld it will be referred to the grading panel for further consideration. You need to be aware that simply because your appeal is upheld does not automatically mean that you will be regraded.

Please be advised that no member of the grading panel or executive is able to discuss the decisions made at grading by the panel. If you wish to appeal and your appeal fits the above criteria please go to the forms section of the website where the Member Protection Form can be found, appeals not submitted on this form will not be considered.

All appeals must be received by the Secretary no later than 7.00 pm on Wednesday 17th February 2021.

Appeals will be heard within forty-eight hours of this date.
